Neal Williams Named Faculty

Co-Director of the Honey and Pollination

Center

Neal Williams is an associate professor of entomology and a core faculty member in the Agricultural Sustainability Institute at UC Davis. His work ranges from basic research in bee biology and pollination to applied research on native bee conservation and crop pollination. Williams investigates the evolution and ecology of pollen specialization by bees and how such specialists contribute to plant reproduction compared to generalists. He also explores the role of habitat connectivity for the persistence of bees in agri-natural landscapes and how pollination service by native bee species is affected by land use change and human disturbance. Finally, Williams is working to develop native plant mixtures to bolster populations of the honey bee and wild bee species and promote sustainable pollination in different agricultural systems.



**Second Annual Irish Beerfest** 

On March 17th, 2016, nearly 500 people attended the Irish Beer Fest, a partnership between the Mondavi Center for the Performing Arts and the Robert Mondavi Institute.
